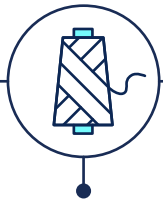

373 persons with disabilities trained and employed



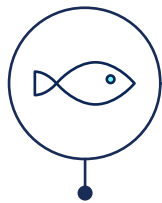
175 855kg of textile waste recycled
